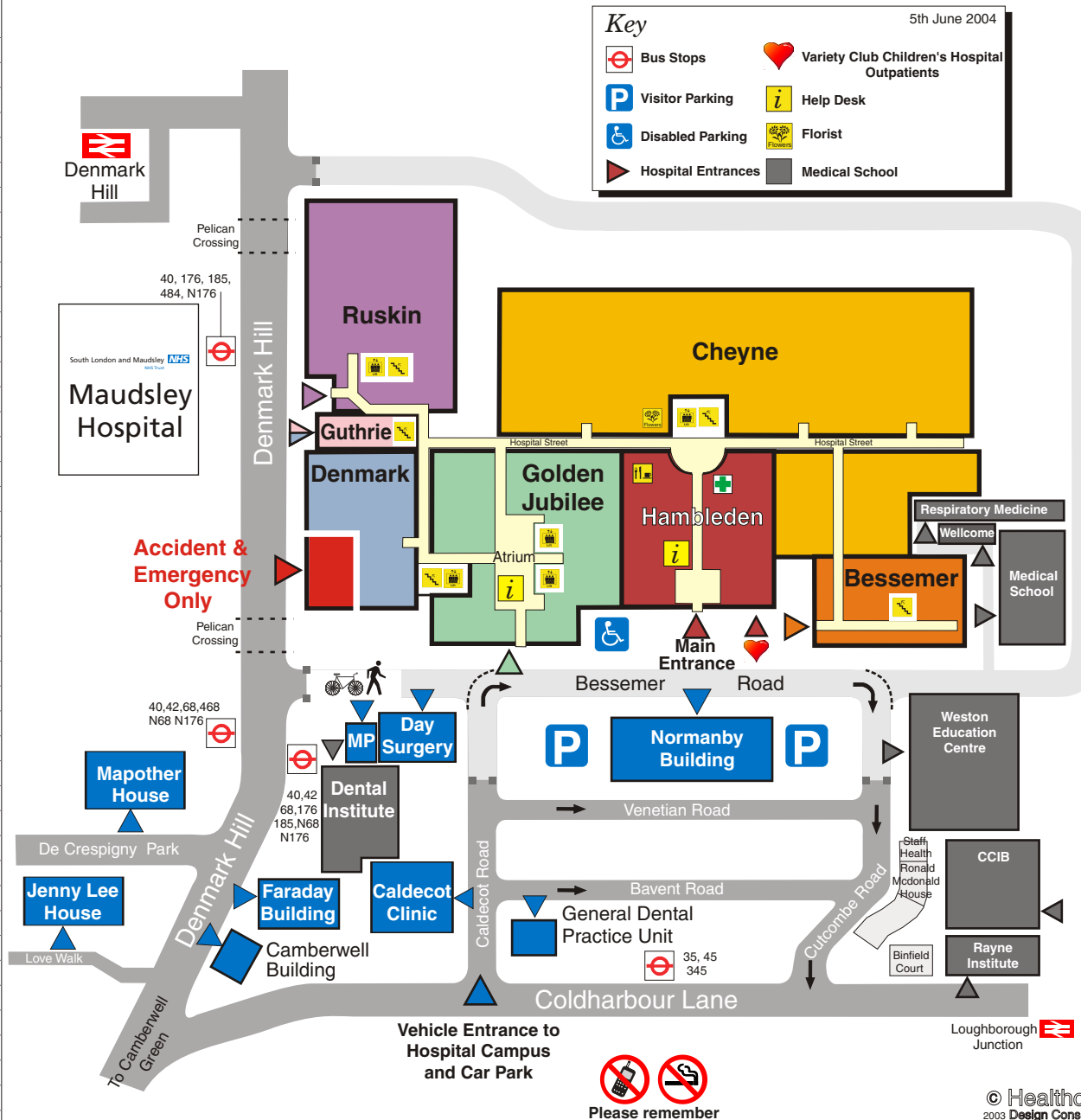


Catering
